

NAFA Policies 2010-2011

Private & Class Lessons

Private lessons have open enrollment throughout the year and are offered on a weekly basis in 30, 45 and 60 minute blocks. At this time, class lessons are unique to the Ballet program only and the length depends on the particular class. Classes have a minimum enrollment of 2 students.

Registration

All **new** students must complete a registration form, schedule a lesson time and submit a down payment before lessons can commence. When a student enrolls, he or she is committing to at least a full semester of study. There is a 2-week grace period in which a new student may withdraw from the academy. However, the student will bear responsibility to pay the tuition for the 2 lessons received. The only circumstances under which a student may completely withdraw from the academy **and** receive tuition reimbursement are prolonged illness, relocation, or other special situations approved by the Director.

Lessons & Scheduling

During the registration process each student will choose an instructor and set up a convenient lesson time. Typically lessons occur on a weekly basis except for special holidays and breaks. Please refer to the NAFA calendar. A copy of the NAFA calendar can be obtained in the office, online or from an instructor. In the event of inclement weather please tune in to WSYR Channel 9 for NAFA cancellations.

Make Up Policy

We consider your lesson time to be a standing appointment. If the teacher has to cancel a lesson, the student will be notified and the lesson will be rescheduled. If a student has to cancel a lesson, 24 hour notice is required. However, if a student wakes up ill the morning of a lesson, please call the instructor as soon as possible. Instructors are not obligated, but can make up student-cancelled lessons at their discretion.

End of Semester Recitals

It is important for students to witness other students accomplishments. There is also great value in students performing publicly for family and peers. Therefore, each student (5-18 yrs.) will be strongly encouraged to perform at the end of year recitals. More information about recitals will be announced.

Tuition & Registration Fees

NAFA is a not-for-profit organization. NAFA tuition covers all lessons, administrative expenses, salaries and recital expenses. Lesson books, ballet shoes and other equipment are not covered by tuition. Private students enrolling mid semester or mid year will have their tuition pro-rated. Students can pay in full, pay per semester or pay monthly according to the NAFA billing cycle. Tuition is reviewed annually. Returned checks are subject to a \$25 fee. Scholarships are available through application only. Please **DO NOT** pay your instructor directly. ****Payment Policy**

Accounts paid by installment that are more than 30 days overdue will be charged a 1.5% late fee.
