Private Lessons & Classes

Private lessons are offered in increments of 30, 45 and 60 minute blocks. Classes are typically 60 minutes. Indicate lesson length on the registration form. Lesson and class tuition differ from each other due to the nature of their instruction.

Registration

To begin the enrollment process students must complete a registration form, agree to a payment plan and schedule a lesson time with the desired instructor. Enrollment guarantees your place for the entire school year.

Tuition & Fees

NAFA tuition covers all lesson, administrative and equipment expenses. Curriculum, attire and other instrument accessories are not covered by tuition. Please consult the registration form for tuition and fee details. There is also an annual registration fee with a family maximum. Tuition can be paid in full at registration, paid per semester or billed monthly. In special cases students are allowed to pay per lesson. Tuition is subject to re-evaluation each Fall.

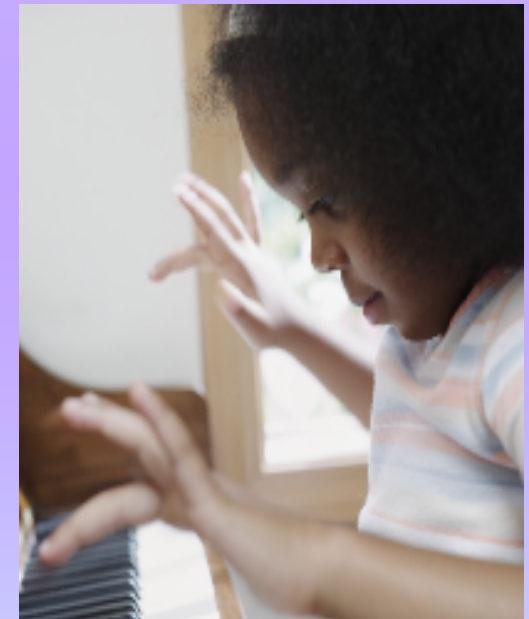
