Private Lessons

Registration

Tuition & Fees

NAFA tuition covers all lesson, administrative and equipment expenses. Music books, guitar strings and other accessories are not covered by tuition. Please consult the registration form for tuition details. Tuition can be paid in full at registration, paid per semester or billed monthly. In special cases students are allowed to pay per lesson. Tuition is subject to re-evaluation each Fall.
