## 1. We've been broken by sin.

Therefore, just as sin came into the world through one man, and death through sin, and so death spread to all men because all sinned - Romans 5:12

We live in a broken world.

In this world, people throw away what has been broken.

God can heal what has been broken.

My spirit is broken; my days are extinct; the graveyard is ready for me . . . My days are past; my plans are broken off, the desires of my heart. Job 17:1, 11

All creation groans with pain. Romans 8:22

## 2. We've been bruised and beaten by Satan.

The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy. John 10:10a

# 3. We've been bought and blessed by the Savior!

Knowing that you were ransomed from the futile ways inherited from your forefathers, not with perishable things such as silver or gold, but with the precious blood of Christ, like that of a lamb without blemish or spot. 1 Peter 1:18-19

#### What do we learn from this first principle?

- 1. Acknowledging spiritual bankruptcy is the first step toward life to the fullest.
- 2. Jesus didn't die to make you miserable.
- 3. Less of you and more of Him is the recipe for life.
- 4. Without Him you have nothing but with Him you have everything.

# Takeaways:

To be poor in spirit means I depend on the Lord – not myself – and that is the key to His blessing.

1. I depend on God's wisdom, not mine.

Trust in the Lord with all your heart; do not depend on your own understanding. Seek His will in all you do, and He will direct your paths. Don't be impressed with your own wisdom: Instead respect the Lord and turn your back on evil. Proverbs 3:5-7, NLT

2. I depend on God's strength, not mine.

I walk in the strength of the Lord. Psalm 71:16a, LB

3. I depend on God's timing, not mine.

God has set the right time for everything. Ecc. 3:11, TEV

4. I depend on God's defense, not mine.

I depend on God alone; I put my hope in Him. He alone protects and saves me; He is my defender, and I shall never be defeated. My salvation and honor depend on God; He is my strong protector; He is my shelter! Psalm 62:5-7, GNT

5. I depend on God's wealth, not mine.

And my God will supply every need of yours according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus. Philippians 4:19
