'I am not the Christ.' John 1:20b

He said, 'I am the voice of one crying out in the wilderness, 'make straight the way of the Lord,' as the prophet Isaiah said.' John 1:23

John answered them, 'I baptize with water, but among you stands one you do not know, even he who comes after me, the strap of whose sandal I am not worthy to untie.' John 1:26-27

The next day he saw Jesus coming toward him, and said, 'Behold the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world!' John 1:29

This is he of whom I said, 'After me comes a man who ranks before me, because he was before me.' John 1:30

The next day again John was standing with two of his disciples, and he looked at Jesus as he walked by and said, 'Behold the Lamb of God!' John 1:35-36

The two disciples heard him say this, and they followed Jesus. John 1:37

One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, 'We have found the Messiah' (which means Christ). He brought him to Jesus. John 1:40-42a

4. A _____ meets Jesus. (vs. 43-51)

a. The _____

The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, 'Follow me'. John 1:43

Philip found Nathanael and said to him, 'We have found him of whom Moses in the Law and also the prophets wrote, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph. Nathanael said to him, 'Can anything good come out of Nazareth?' Philip said to him, 'Come and see.' John 1:45-46

b. The _____

Jesus saw Nathanael coming toward him and said of him, 'Behold an Israelite indeed, in whom there is no deceit!' Nathanael said to him, 'How do you know me?' Jesus answered him, 'Before Philip called you, when you were under the fig tree, I saw you.' Nathanael answered him, 'Rabbi, you are the Son of God! You are the King of Israel!' John 1:47-49
